



Mission and Approach

The New Jersey Technology Solutions Center (NJTSC) is a 501(c)(3)/509(a)(2) NJ nonprofit Corporation whose focus is to build and operate a technology-focused employment and business development capability for the benefit of the State of New Jersey. This mission is accomplished through the efforts of a diverse team of more than 40 high technology large and small business corporations and leading academic institutions in New Jersey.

NJTSC's approach is to coordinate with its Team Members to develop business prospects, propose, win and perform scientific research and development on communication, command, control, computing, intelligence, surveillance, reconnaissance (C4ISR), renewable/alternative energy, homeland defense, cyber/EW/security and health information technology. This is achieved by employing subject matter experts (SMEs) in these fields in the State of New Jersey. This is one of the ways in which NJTSC seeks to benefit the Federal Government while focusing on the public purpose of growing jobs in New Jersey.

Background

NJTSC was created in response to a solicitation from the New Jersey Department of Labor and Workforce Development in September 2008. NJTSC's primary mission is to deliver economic benefit to New Jersey, especially in the Monmouth region, through the creation of a viable, growing portfolio of technology-based business that leverages the deep intellectual and human capital resources of the region, fuels the growth of high skill, high technology jobs and facilitates the creation of new, innovative business ventures in New Jersey. One key way in which NJTSC plans to accomplish its public purpose is by performing scientific and engineering tasks that make use of the knowledge, skills and abilities of appropriate subject matter experts in New Jersey, especially those who are able to benefit both the State of New Jersey and the US Government. NJTSC is building a technology center of excellence in the Central New Jersey region that will allow federal, state and local agencies, and America's allies, to take advantage of these talents and capabilities. NJTSC is seeking contracts from Federal Agencies and private industry. NJTSC is seeking contracts for research, development and training from Federal Agencies and private industry in C4ISR, Renewable/Alternative Energy, Homeland Defense/Security and Cyber/EW/Security, Health Information Technology and related fields.

NJTSC Initiatives

NJTSC has created two focus initiatives each based on capabilities of NJTSC Team Members. The first Initiative, begun in early 2011, in alternate energy (especially from solar) has led to in-process development activities for NJTSC Team Members. The second initiative, just begun in 2012, in Health Information Technology (HIT) is seeking to enable Team Members to complement each other's capabilities to provide a broad range of HIT services. This Health IT initiative draws on the diverse skills and capabilities of NJTSC Team Members, including adaptation of advanced solutions from other application domains, to provide agile, multi-disciplinary solutions that help government and private Health IT clients and partners meet challenges in areas as varied as advanced instrumentation, informatics, tele-health/ tele-medicine, cloud and mobility services, information and cyber security, electronic records management, health care delivery and business systems. In support of this initiative NJTSC is Master of Ceremonies at the New Jersey Technology Council's 2012 New Jersey Health Information Technology Summit on *Connected Healthcare* on July 19 at the NJ Hospital Association in Princeton, New Jersey.
