HEALTH INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY



CHALLENGE

Health Information Technology (HIT) is increasingly viewed as one of the most promising tools for improving the overall quality, safety, and efficiency of the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) health care delivery system. Public and private health care systems, in addition to VA, are not only looking for ways to incorporate Health Information Technologies into their patient care programs and administrative processes, but also for ways to use HIT tools to foster collaboration among health care providers and to connect rural or remote patients to health care professionals.
