- 1. VA Handbook 6500, *Risk Management Framework for VA Information Systems Tier 3: VA Information Security Program Policy* requires the use of a VA approved method to connect external systems to VA's network. CAG is the current VA approved method for users when they must use or manipulate VA information for official VA business. CAG authorized users are not permitted to print or save VA information to their personal computers.
- 2. In addition, VA prohibits access to VA's network from non-NATO countries. The exception to this are countries where VA has approved operations established (e.g., Philippines and South Korea).
