Prior to that, she served as Deputy Director of the Acquisition and Resource Integration, Naval Facilities Command, responsible for enterprise-wide acquisition and resource integration for the White House Military Office, Policy, Plans and Requirements directorate.

Mrs. Brazell served on active duty in the United States Army from 1984-1988, then spent 17 years as a DoD contractor before joining the DoD civilian service in 2006.

Mrs. Brazell earned a Bachelor's of Science in Computer Science from Chapman University and a Masters of Arts in Organizational Management from the University of Phoenix.
